Description of the sample

The foldable mask is sold in white and black colour and consists of 4 layers:

- 1. outer spunbond: polypropylene
- 2. meltblown plypropylene
- 3. fluffy mailinger polypropylene
- 4. inner sounbond: polypropylene

The nose clip is made of plastic covered wire. The elastic earband is made of polypropylene/lycra. The mask is provided with a clip made of polypropylene which can fix the mask on the head more tightly.

- filling a small basket 20x in 10 min;
